The scholarship endowment is funded by gifts from the Woodley family, colleagues, and organizations from around the Commonwealth. Who can nominate students for this scholarship:

- A VirginiaCAN partner organization in good standing (must have attended at least 2 out of 3 of VirginiaCAN's annual conferences since 2021)
 - The nominating organization must provide higher education access activities directly to high school students.
- DO NOT encourage all of your students to submit applications. Instead, it is recommended that the nominating organization identify two or three students that best meet the scholarship criteria and then work specifically with those students to submit applications.
- Only the first three complete applications per organization, submitted by the deadline, will be accepted.

Application and Selection Notification Deadlines:

Applications must be submitted by April 1, 2024. The recipients and nominating organizations will be notified of their selection via email no later than April 26, 2024.

Scholarship Awards:

The scholarship committee will award \$1,000 scholarships to four students for the 2024-2025 academic year.

Selection Criteria:

- 2024 high school graduate; intending to enroll at least half-time at an institution of higher education no later than fall 2024
- Significant volunteer service
 - \circ $\;$ The student's volunteer service need not necessarily have been with the nominating organization.
 - In order to qualify as volunteer service:
 - The student cannot be paid. The service organization may not be for-profit.
 - The work must benefit someone outside of the student's immediate or extended family.
 - Service to the following types of organizations generally qualify: Hospitals, homeless shelters, animal shelters, after-school programs, charities, religious organizations, environmental organizations
- Strength of academics and student-submitted essay
- Financial need
- Special consideration for first-generation college students and students from single-parent households

IMPORTANT: Recipients will be required to complete an Intent to Enroll form and provide a valid Social Security Number (SSN) or Individual Tax ID Number (ITIN) to receive the scholarship payment. They will also be asked to submit an electronic photo of themselves and be invited (but not required) to participate in the 2024 VirginiaCAN conference.

It does not allow for you to save as a draft; therefore, it is important that you read through the information below and gather the information and documents before starting the application.
