# • Joy Pugh calls meeting to order at 2:02pm

- Approval of December Meeting Minutes
  - Anne moves to approve, February minutes as shared
    - Lyons seconds
  - 11 ayes, 0 nays, 0 abstentions

# • Treasurer's Report

- VCAN Account Balance: \$68,265.07
  - 4,464.00 spent for SHEV on Calendly
  - Once reimbursed, we'll be back at 72,729.00

### • Statewide FAFSA Initiative

- Access members came together to address decline in FAFSA completion
  - As of Monday, 90 FAFSA had been submitted, 30 this week
    - Data is compiled by Tomika Brown
    - Specific outreach is taking place
  - Only problem identified is "no-shows" for appointments
    - Many factors could contribute to this
      - $\circ$   $\;$  intimidation factor of not knowing who is there
      - other reasons
    - Having more Spanish speakers to help with FAFSA
  - Other states have reached out to us about this initiative
    - Speaks to VirginiaCAN's spirit of collaboration
    - Opened up an opportunity for an NCAN grant
  - Other stats
    - Over 60 advisors currently
      - most 1 advisor has advised in 5, so very low commitment
    - The program will only continue through June 30th
    - Unless we see a big influx, no need for more advisors currently

- Suggestions
  - Joy: data collection, analyzing impact & reach
  - Sarah: feedback survey, choose times, follow-up
  - Reshaud: partnering the initiative with other efforts
  - TeCarla: ensuring no-shows are helped (maybe locally)
- Replication Efforts
  - Governor & Secretary will likely want to want to do this annually
  - Looking at funding, expectations, responsible entity
    - Joy & Erin sitting on state-wide FAFSA task force

      - High schoolers will likely not qualify
